DRAWING EVIDENCE		IMPROVEMENT ADVICE
Struggling to grasp the concept of measuring with pencil, arm isn't straight or can't get how to repeat the sizes.	IN1	It is not easy to learn how to measure in this way, so maybe you need a little extra help to grasp it.
When you look at the drawing, some of the sizes are obviously wrong.	IN2	Some of your measuring looks a little out to me. Go back and check it to make sure you got them right.
You see lots of crossings out or repeated rubbing out with the old lines still showing.	IN3	There are crossings out and rubbings out on the paper. You don't need to do this if you followed the rules of sketching lightly! Mistakes are fine, just leave them in your book. Mistakes are ok in art.
Has obviously missed out one or more of these: 1. Study the object & plan the drawing 2. Measure 3. Sketch it out 4. Apply shading and detail.	IN4	You don't seem to be following these stages when you draw. One or more of them are either missing or not done correctly. Can you see which ones?
When shading the white objects they get the light and dark areas in the wrong place	IN5	You made a great effort when shading the white object, but you have put some of the dark areas and light areas in the wrong places. Can you work out what is wrong?
Select which parts of the statement are relevant and circle them.	IN6	The still life drawing is a lovely effort and you have done extremely well. But if we are going to make you an amazing artist then you need to just tighten up on a few things.  • Make sure you measure things accurately.  • Get that shading as neat as you can.  • Some extra details will improve it.  • Your shadows aren't quite right.  • Spend some time making the dark tones on your drawing a little darker. Make the edges neater.  • Add more detail,  • Improve your shadows and highlights.
